Clinton Christian School seeks to provide quality education in a nurturing, Christian environment. Each student is encouraged to realize his or her full potential. An integral part of the educational process is the challenge for students to accept responsibility or their commitment to personal integrity. Therefore, students attending CCS must sign and support the following CODE OF HONOR PLEDGE to enhance the quality of life on campus. Should any of the commitments made in this pledge be difficult for the student to affirm, the student should not enroll in CCS. Clinton Christian School exists in order to provide each student with the opportunity to acknowledge and respond, through faith, to the Word of God while participating in an educational program which stresses academic, artistic, social, emotional and physical development. If your child has a different philosophy of life, then your child may not be a good candidate for the student body at CCS. While attending CCS, each student in grades 4-12 must agree to uphold the following.

### **Code of Honor Pledge**

As a member of the student body of Clinton Christian School, I desire to enhance the quality of the student body by pledging my support to the following **CODE OF HONOR. I PLEDGE TO:**

- Be truthful and respectful to my God-given home authority (parent/guardian) at all times.
- Follow the teaching of the Bible and its values and be an example of these teachings both on and off campus.

- Abstain from the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and immoral behavior as defined by Scripture, which includes, but is not limited to premarital sex and homosexual behavior, thus honoring my body as the temple of the Holy Spirit.
- Exert a positive influence in my social relationships and to be a responsible member of the school community.
- Be truthful and respectful to teachers, staff members and administrators at all times.
- Not cheat on class work, homework, quizzes, tests, exams, projects, or assignments.
- Follow the rules and regulations in the School Handbook and to actively encourage others to do the same.
- Refrain from posting anti-Christian web pages as defined by Clinton Christian School.
- Refrain from sending or receiving inappropriate electronic communications.
- Honor God and classmates through respectful participation in chapel.
- Not use vulgar language, or profanity in person or on web pages or electronic communications.
- To support the following school-wide standards:
  - Follow directions when they are given.
  - Help keep the school building and property free of trash.
  - Abstain from calling students and school personnel inappropriate names.
  - Obey the school "closed campus" policy.
  - No lying, cheating, stealing, forgery, coercion, or fighting.
  - Conduct myself in a manner that does not disturb others.
  - Stay out of the areas that the school has classified as "off limits."
  - Abide by the school dress code.
