The Administrator's Corner

I must take this opportunity to thank our marvelous students, their supportive parents and our exemplary faculty and staff for helping to create an excellent school year. Nevertheless, I am overjoyed by the vote of confidence from re-enrolling parents of Clinton Christian School students. Many years ago I learned that by substituting my name, the name of a loved one and the name of the Christian school in place of the proper nouns and pronouns in Scripture, I could know exactly for what to pray. Consider Psalm 34 as I make the following substitutions: Clinton Christian School will bless the LORD at all times: His praise shall continually be in the school's mouth. I recognize that I am for all practical purposes the school's mouth.
